Heard Ld. Counsel Mr. Rishabh Verma appearing for the Applicants and Ld. Public Prosecutor Mr. Yubaraj Chatterjee appearing on behalf of the State. The Ld. Counsel submits that F.I.R. No. 176/19 u/s 307/326/498A IPC, 1860 was registered in the Police Station Mukherjee Nagar, North Delhi.

Ld. Counsel for the Applicants submits that accused have been falsely charged in the aforesaid F.I.R. and also submits that the accused Bhakti Ram is suffering from sugar disease as his sugar level is very high and he needs immediate medical attention. Considering this fact the court directs the superintendent of jail to provide medical treatment twice in a day by jail doctor.

Ld. Public prosecutor submits that the victim is still critical and she is in hospital (certificates attached) and two more witnesses are to testify the alleged offence. In the foresaid circumstances this court considers that bail should not be granted. Bail is rejected and the application is disposed off. Copy of this Order should be given in *dasti* to the parties and accused.
