Having heard both the Counsel this court is of the opinion that there is no ground of quashing the alleged F.I.R. in the present F.I.R. However showing the concern Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that two of the accused namely Ankit and Rahul aged 18 and 19 respectively are having their term exam which is likely to commence from Monday 14.10.2019. Ld. AGA is having no objection with respect to the same. This court gives the direction to the jail authorities to make proper arrangements for their study as well as to ensure that they reach to college centre on time for giving their examination. The petition stands dismissed with the foresaid directions with no cost to parties.
