Bail application has been filed in F.I.R. No. 122/2019 dated 09.09.2019 PS Greater Kailash in which four accused Govind Pandit, Satyarg Guruji, Amrita Nair and Ganesh were charged for kidnapping, causing hurt attempt to commit culpable homicide, rape and murder. Two of the accused Mr. Govind Pandit and Satyarg Guruji were sent to the police custody on 19.09.2019 and till now no *prima facie* evidence were produced by the police against the accused person.

Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that the accused has been falsely implicated since police could not produce any reliable evidence that *prima facie* establishes the cases so far accused are ready to furnish the bail bond of Rupees 50,000 each and assure the court that they are going to cooperate with the police in the investigation process. The court grants bail to all the four accused on the condition that accused shall not leave the city without the permission of SHO and will not affect the witness in this case directly or indirectly. Copy of this Order should be given in dasti to the parties and accused. The bail application is disposed off.
