Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that FIR No. 42/2019 dated 10/09/2019 PS Karol Bagh has been registered against the accused in which he has been implicated with the charge of Section 354, 354D and 509 of IPC, 1860. It is submitted that accused has already been sent in the Police custody by the Ld. Magistrate from 10.09.2019 to 20.09.2019. Ld. Public Prosecutor submits that the accused is having a past criminal record of doing the same offence and since the offence for which he has been implicated are offences against the women and it requires proper investigation on part of the police.

Ld. Public Prosecutor has no objection if bail is granted to the accused in this matter, but keeping in view the past record of the accused this court grants the bail to the accused on furnishing the bond and surety for Rupees One lakh only (Rs. 1,00,000/-) with a condition that accused will ensure his

daily presence before the station house officer till the time Chargesheet is filed by the prosecution and accused will not meet any witness related to this case directly or indirectly.

The copy of this order will be given to the S.P. as well as to the accused. The matter is disposed off. Bail Granted.
