This application was filed under section 482 of Cr.P.C, 1973 with a view that the F.I.R. No. 145/19 dated 07/09/2019 registered in Malviya Nagar police station should be quashed exercising the inherent power by this court.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that there is some overwriting in the F.I.R. and there are some suspicion with respect to the charges and implication against the accused. Further Counsel submits that the accused are in judicial custody and they should be granted bail.

Ld. AGA appearing on the behalf of the State submitted that investigation is going on in this matter and the police have also received the F.S.L. report that corroborates the involvement of one of the accused in the alleged incident.

Having heard the Counsel for the parties this court is of the opinion that there is no ground for quashing the impugned F.I.R. as the charges are very grave and there is *prima facie* involvement of the accused in this case the police is directed to continue with the investigation and file the Chargesheet as soon as possible so that trial can be conducted within time. The petition stands dismissed with no cost to parties.
