Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the F.I.R. No. 120/19 U/s 376/323/506 IPC PS: Model Town appears to be a fake FIR as there was a delay in lodging the FIR, there was 2 days delay in lodging the FIR after receiving the information for the same.

The learned counsel further submits that police has sent the victim 'x' for medical examination on 3rd of September, whereas the FIR was register on the 5th of September 2019. There could be a situation where after the receiving of information police was so quick in getting the victim of sexual offence medically examined for the prediction of scientific evidences in the sexual offence against a woman. That nowhere shows that the case has been implanted by the police.

This court does not deny the fact that there is a delay in lodging the FIR by the police but that is not a ground for quashing of FIR.

Having heard both Counsels this court is of the opinion that this petition deserves no merit and hence, stands dismissed with the direction to police that no coercive action shall be taken against the accused. With this th petition is dismissed with no cost requirements.
