Description of parcel(s) received:

- (a) One sealed packet said to contain blood stained small Pink T-shirt – duly labelled as (A).
- (b) One sealed packet said to contain blood stained small Pink half-Pant – duly labelled as (B).
- (c) Blood samples from the body of the deceased duly sealed in small glass bottle and duly labelled as (C).
- (d) One sealed plastic packet contained Blood stained Knife - duly labelled as (D).
- (e) One sealed plastic packet contained cotton swabs with blood stains- duly labelled as (E)

All the above materials were separately sealed in their respective plastic packets or containers.

RESULTS OF ANALYSIS

- All samples examined reveals that it is human blood.
- 1) Blood on Exhibit labelled (C) is Blood Group –O(Rh+ve).
- 2) Blood stains on Exhibit labelled (A) is Blood Group – O(Rh+ve) and matches with the Exhibit labelled (C).

- 3) Blood stains on Exhibit labelled (B) is Blood Group – O(Rh+ve) and matches with the blood present in Exhibit labelled (C).
- 4) Blood stains on Exhibit labelled (D) is Blood Group – O(Rh+ve) and matches with the blood present in Exhibit labelled (C).
- 5) Blood stains on Exhibit labelled (E) is Blood Group – O(Rh+ve) and matches with the blood present in Exhibit labelled (C).

Result- The blood in all the labelled items is of the same person.
