

Brief history of the case (As per Inquest papers):

The daughter of complainant Ms. Richa Kumar alleged that her husband has killed her daughter namely Aashima aged about 5 yrs onn 20.11.2018 and buried the dead body in the children graveyard situated near Gautam river, Gautam Nagar, U.P. In the supervision of SDM Sood, FSL Team and doctors team of Kailash Hospital, the body is dig out at the instance of accused Mr. Arun and the body identified by the daughter of the complainant and the complainant. The dead body is brought for Postmortem.




(A) General observation

Dr. Neha was directed to go at the graveyard near the bank of Gautam river, Gautam Nagar by Dr. Ashok, Head of the Department, Department of Forensics, Kailash Hospital to observe exhumation and to take the dead body of the child mentioned in inquest paper with the investigating officer to mortuary for it and reached the graveyard at 11:30 Am alongwith the I.O. The grave was identified by father of the deceased with the help of I.O. and digging with helper was started. The soil was wet and mixed with grey and brown coloured stones. On digging till depth 55 cm, a red coloured cloth appeared in the pit

and again was identified by the father of the deceased with the help of I.O. tied in a red cloth. On removal of the dead body the grave measured 110 cm (length) x 45 cm (breadth) x 90 cm (depth). On opening the red cloth, a partially skeletonized and partially adipocered body of a child, with a knife cut on neck, was recovered wearing blue and yellow skirt and, yellow top with a cut and having red blood marks on the yellow top, identified by the father, mother and grandfather of the deceased in the presence of Investigating Officer. The body was wrapped in the same red cloth, tied in a plastic apron and a red plastic sheet. The FSL team was advised to take the soil sample from the grave site. In the presence of I.O., the dead body was taken for transfer to mortuary, Kailash Hospital. The body was removed from the grave site at 12:30Pm and was taken from the graveyard alongwith the I.O. at 12:40Pm and reached the Kailash Hospital Mortuary at 01:05 Pm alongwith the dead body of the child. At 02:10 Pm the inquest papers were received from the I.O. and the postmortem examination was started after identification. It was a partially skeletonized and partially adipocered human dead body of a female child, with a knife cut on its neck, wrapped in a red plastic sheet and tied in a plastic apron and then wrapped in red mud stained cloth. The dead body is wearing blue skirt with yellow strips and yellow top having red blood marks on it. On removal of the clothes, partially skeletonized body with a knife cut on the neck, and partially adipocere. Grievous injuries on head, face, chest, abdomen and back. Legs and feet are not identifiable. Soft tissue over lower abdomen discolored due to decomposition. Bones are lying distinguished. Skull bones are lying with a skull cavity empty. Internal soft organs are unidentifiable due to advanced decomposition. The Post-mortem report was concluded at 03:45 Pm.

2. Sealed box containing clothes of the deceased
3. Sealed box containing red cloth that was wrapped on the body of deceased.
4. Sealed body containing mud sample found on the body of the deceased.
